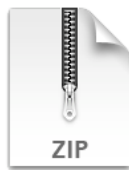

INSTALLATION

Download the software installer.

Depending on your browser and browser settings you will either end with something like this in your downloads folder (probably your desktop):



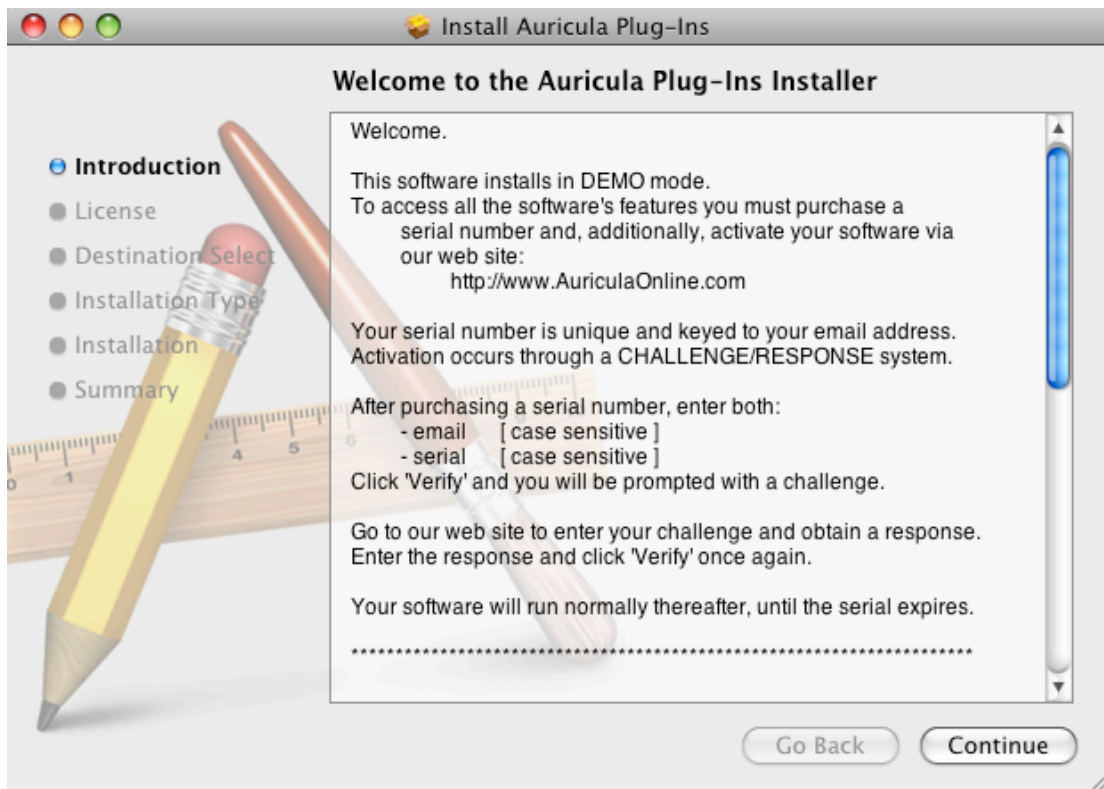
Or this:



If the former – a ‘zip’ file – double click it to decompress it.

You should now have an executable package – an ‘mpkg’ file.

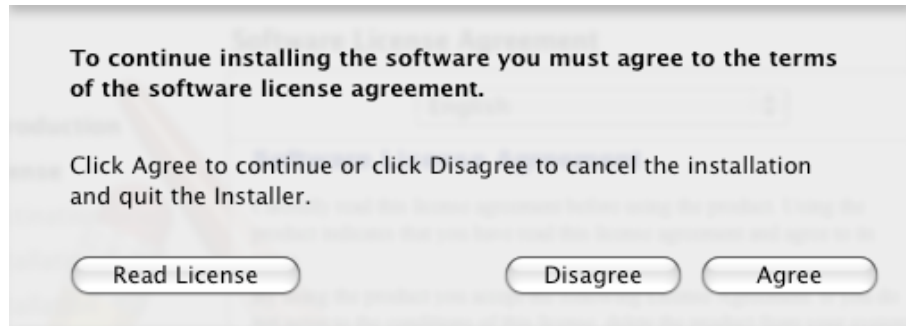
Double click this installation package to launch the installer.
Click Continue.



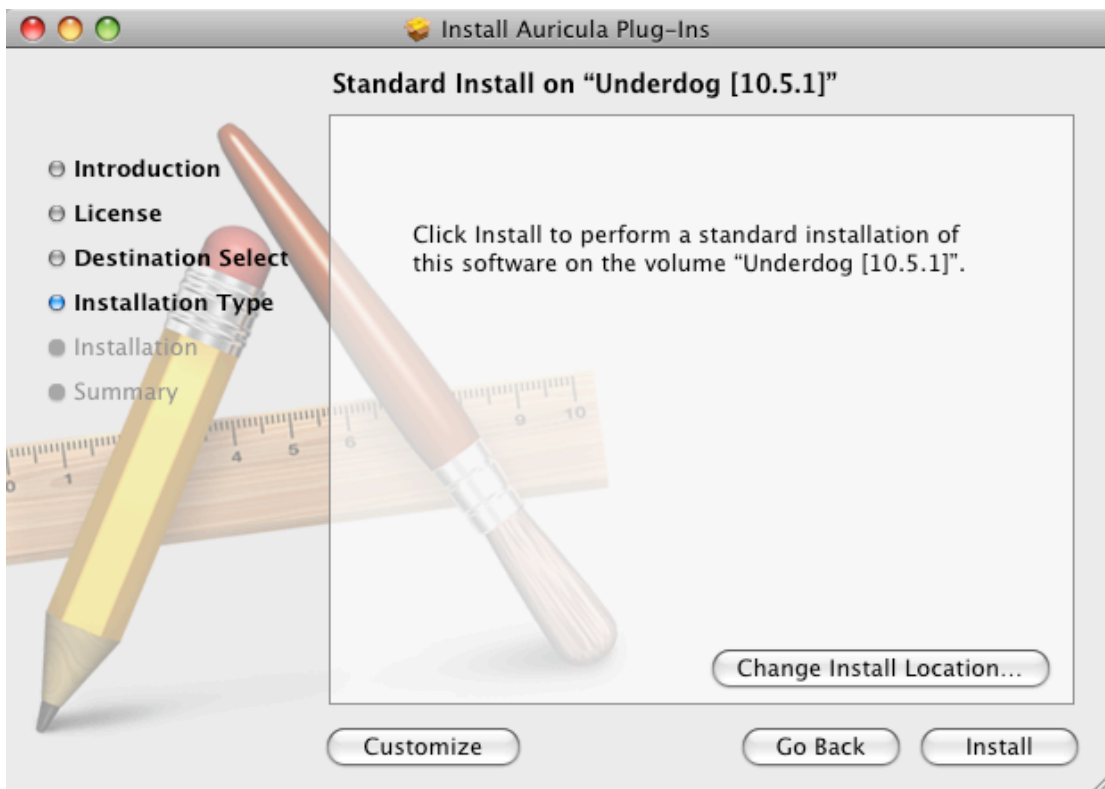
Read the agreement – click Continue.



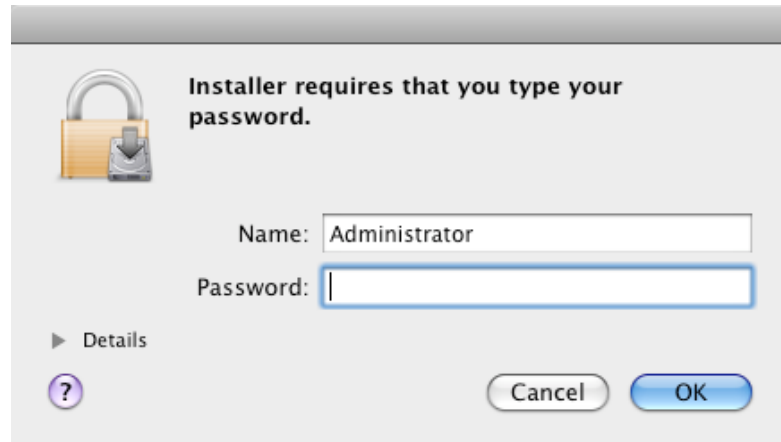
Click Agree.



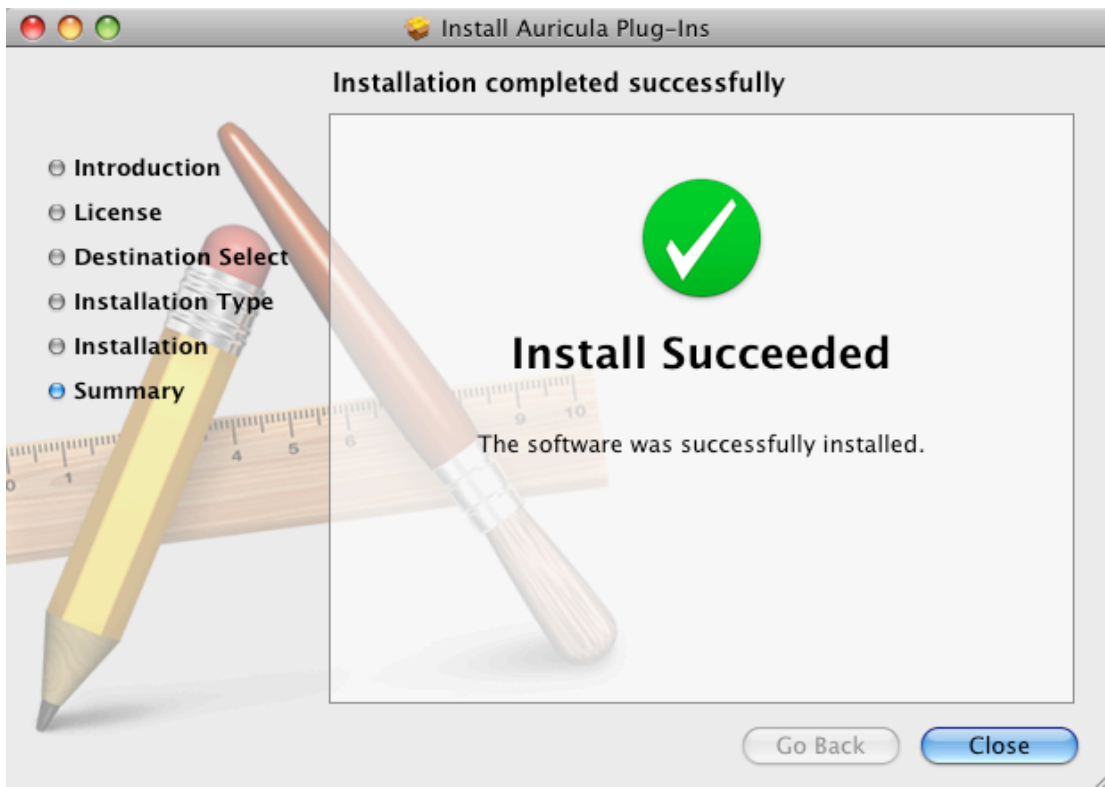
If you want to install just a single plug-in click customize, otherwise click Install.



Enter your administrator password – click OK.



Watch the progress bar...
Click Close.



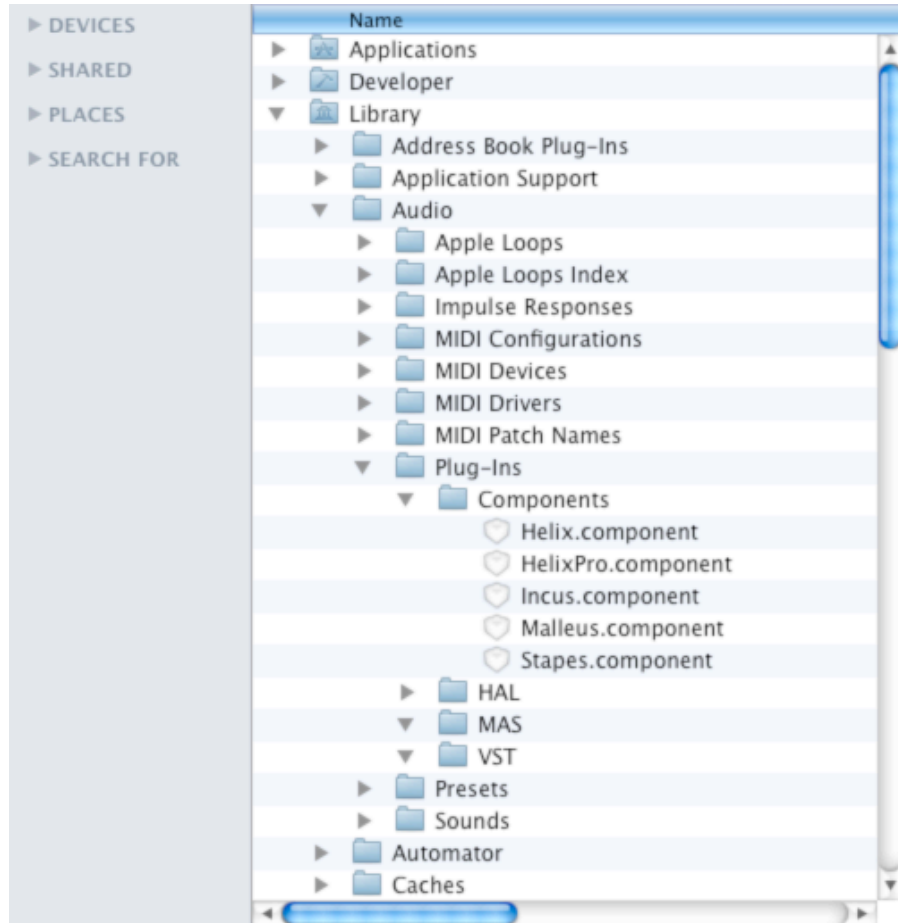
UNINSTALLING THE SOFTWARE

In the Finder, double click your startup disk.

Navigate to:

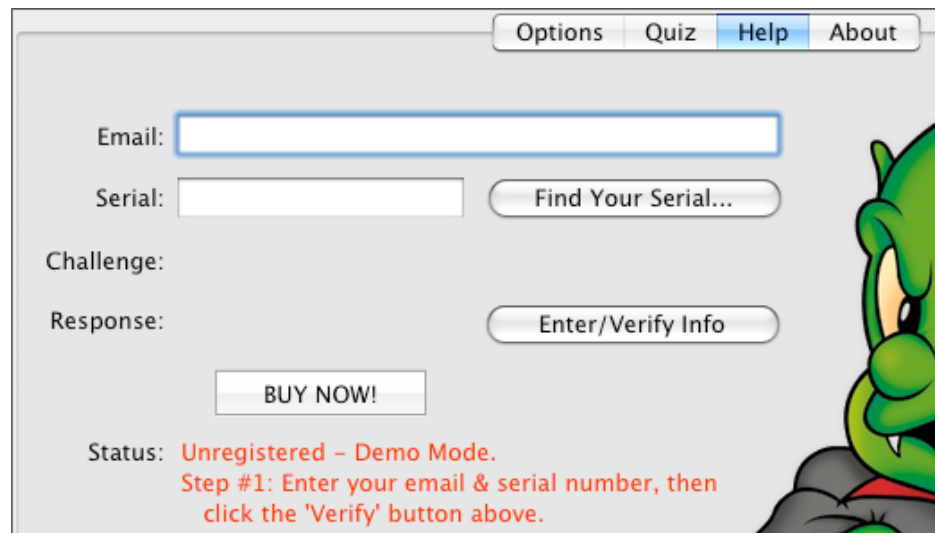
/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/

Manually drag the plug-in(s) you no longer want to use to the trash.



DEMO MODE

When you first launch one of the Auricula plug-ins, you should see something like this:



It is not necessary to enter any information at this time.

To use this plug-in in demo mode, just exit the Help screen by clicking on the OPTIONS or QUIZ tabs.

In demo mode you may not take a complete quiz, some questions will be disabled.

To enable all questions and take a complete quiz you must purchase and authorize your plug-in.


MANUAL AUTHORIZATION (*should automatic authorization fail for some reason*)

Enter the email address you use to access your PayPal account.

Enter the serial number emailed to you shortly after you purchased the plug-in.

If you have forgotten your serial number, click the *Find Your Serial...* button.

When all the information is accurate – this is Case Sensitive – click the *Enter/Verify Info* button.


You will be redirected to the AuriculaOnline web site, where you can request a response.

Please make sure this is in fact the computer you want to install the plug-in on.


If you will be using this plug-in on another computer, DO NOT CONTINUE.

Copy the response from the web page, then paste into the *Response* field.
